Montréal has over 350 kilometres of biking and roller-blading trails that surround the city and there is no better way to get to know the city!

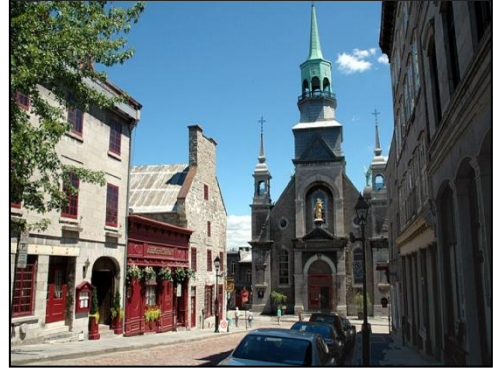
OLD MONTREAL WALKING TOUR – CODE #CIP-0210-PM03

DEPARTS: 1:30 PM (meet at 1:15 pm in lobby of Centre Sheraton hotel)
RETURNS: 4:00 PM (back at hotel)

Discover the birthplace of Montreal and one of the largest concentrations of 17th, 18th, and 19th century buildings in North America!

On this walking tour, your guide will lead you through a maze of narrow cobblestone streets, providing historic commentary and interesting facts. Highlights include:

- *Place d'Armes* and *Place Royale*; historic public squares
- *City Hall* and *Bonsecours Market*; important institutions
- *Château Ramezay*; the oldest private museum of history in Québec
- some of the magnificent banks and buildings on *St-Jacques Street*, formerly known as “Little Wall Street”
- *St-Paul Street*; boutiques, souvenir shops, art galleries, bars and cafés
- *Place Jacques-Cartier*; former site of 17th century skirmishes and now a bustling centre of activity
- *Old Port*; a crucial part of Montreal's development
- and a glimpse at some of the new hotels, restaurants, bars and business that have breathed new life into Old Montreal!



The tour is designed to provide an historic overview and stops are frequent, but brief. There will be a lengthier stop for a guided visit of the Notre-Dame Basilica (*a stunning example of Neo-Gothic architecture and masterpiece of decorative art*)

**** It is not possible to confirm the availability of the Basilica on a Saturday due to possible weddings and private events. Should the Basilica not be available for viewing, a comparable alternative shall be offered in its place. ****

At the end of the tour, your guide will accompany you back to the hotel or you may stay at leisure to enjoy a few more hours in Old Montreal.
